

Greetings Brothers and Sisters,

One afternoon, I met with Bob Bowker, who does the lawn mowing at our church, and we talked about how many trees have been ruined by the millions of sponge moths this year. He said that years ago, when we had millions of sponge moths just like this year, the government sent helicopters to spray and kill all the moths. Thus, many trees were not damaged as they were this time. Hmm, it made me think about our spirituality.

Who could stand strong spiritually without the help from above? When our situations seem to be damaged by something like sponge moths, our spiritual life may go through doubt and distrust, which may result in no fruit or leaves.

And others may interpret it in regard to the following story of temple cleansing (Mark 11:15–19). Then, we may be able to find out how to always be fruitful spiritually and how powerful the spiritual fruits will be! (Mark 11:20–24) Amen!

We cannot bear spiritual fruit without the house of God and without what we are rightly supposed to do in the house of God. This is the way that we can be helped to be fruitful by the divine from above!

The secular calendar tells us that it is the vacation season, but the spiritual calendar tells us that it is always a fruitful season! Wherever you go and whatever you do, please do not forget the way to always be fruitful and the way to share the fruits powerfully! Keep the house of God with you!






We invite you to share your prayer concerns and joys with us.


Pastor Sung uses the church **Outreach Fund** at his discretion to help folks in the community with all kinds of emergencies including, electricity, heat, medical etc.

## 'GIFT-OF-THE-GROVE'

A Word of Gratitude  
And an Outreached Invitation

TO: Our DFUMC Congregation

*Ten years ago, in 2014, during the Month of June*, work commenced to initiate the beginnings of the Dingmans Ferry UMC Grove for Prayer and Meditation. At that time, there was no way of knowing that the Prayer Grove would evolve into an Outdoor Ministry site containing Twelve Stations, which provided inspiration for numerous Worship Services and Small Ministry Sessions, as well as a site for Individualized Prayer and Meditation!

The Prayer Grove has proven itself to be one of the most Gratifying and Rewarding pursuits of my Spiritual Life, and I am deeply indebted to all those who played some role in either helping to create it, manage it, or incorporate its features into a meaningful context for Spiritual Prayer, Meditation, and Enlightenment!

But, ultimately, all Pursuits such as this one encounter Changes that require alterations if they seek to be continued. Specifically, as much as I regret it, my advancing age and the circumstances which accompany it, will no longer permit me to be involved in future Grove management and development. Secondarily, changes are occurring to the Grove trees which are resulting in more time required to keep the ground surface below the trees free of fallen branches and leaf and needle litter.

The result of all this is an **Invitational Appeal** to any Members of our Church Family, or any Attendees to our Worship Services or Programs, to *Adopt a Single Station of the Grove* that seems worthy of playing a valued, continuing role in Grove Ministry. Examples of such Grove Stations might be the **Chapel**, the **Prayer Circle**, the 'Journey-of-Faith' Pathway, the 'Symbols-of-Our-Faith' Alcove, and the **St. Francis Meditation Garden**. Adoptees could either be individuals or small teams of individuals that would take *weekly responsibility*, during the 'Open-Grove-Season' (May through September) for checking their Station and maintaining its appearance and integrity as well as possible.

In the weeks ahead, during July and August, I am willing to meet with any individual or team and apprise them of what 'Adoption' of their Preferred Station would involve. *Just contact me at any time to make these arrangements.*

Hopefully, if enough interest in such **Adoptions** is realized, at least a portion of the Original Grove that reached its prime in 2018-2022 will be realized. And, again, **Many Thanks** to All Those who have, heretofore, played an active role in helping to make our Church's **Grove for Prayer and Meditation** a Valued, Outdoor Convening Site for Christian Ministry!

# The Grove at DFUMC

The Grove is a unique place for outdoor prayer and meditation.

The Grove features:

- A 'Music-of-the Spheres' Chapel:

The Chapel gets its name from a key phrase of the hymn, 'O For a Thousand Tongues to Sing,' composed by Charles Wesley, the 'Father' of Methodist Hymns. The Chapel features hymn lyrics on banners and bench plaques, a simulated Cathedral window, and melodic wind chimes.

- The 'Symbols-of-Our-Faith' Alcove:

Highlights three prime symbols of our Christian Faith: the **CROSS**, the **STONE** and the **DOVE**,

The symbolic forms of these Christian icons are set in a stone foundation of red crushed stone that is meant to resemble a Eucharistic wine chalice, since interpretations of the meanings of the CROSS, the STONE and the DOVE are inherently embedded in our weekly celebrated ritual of Holy Communion.

- The Daily Discipleship Prayer Circle:


A circle that embodies twelve Prayer Stones that embrace four domains of our Christian Faith: **Prayer Devotion to God**, **Prayer Contriteness of Heart**, **Outreaching Aura of Prayer**, and **Faith in Prayer Outcome**. A 'Standing Stone' faces each Prayer Stone, and individuals can 'personalize' their Prayer for the week ahead by placing a small, white polished stone beneath a simulated Prayer Plant on the edge of the Prayer Circle.

- CHRISTIAN 'JOURNEY-OF-FAITH' PATHWAY:

A pathway around the Prayer Circle that visually communicates the evolution of one's personal Faith via three miniaturized dioramic displays, which emphasizes **God's Presence** with us and **God's Promise** to us. Key Scriptural passages accompany each of these stations along the Pathway

- The Saint Francis Meditation Garden:

The Garden features a Statue of Saint Francis, an assortment of living garden plants, bench plaques emphasizing the value and quiet meditation from the Prayer of St. Francis of Assisi for All Living Things and the hymn whose lyrics were inspired from that Prayer: "All Creatures of My God and King."



Music Ministry: Join the Choir, Offer to play an Instrument for Special Services, Assist with Audio/Video as needed.




