chairs & nursery furnishings - NO PLUSH PLEASE) are always welcome!

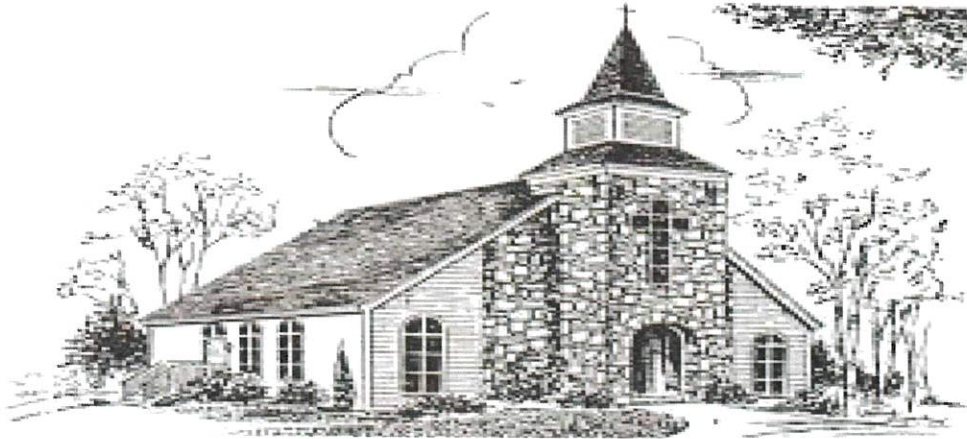
Our pantry is supplied mostly by donations to meet emergency & urgent
