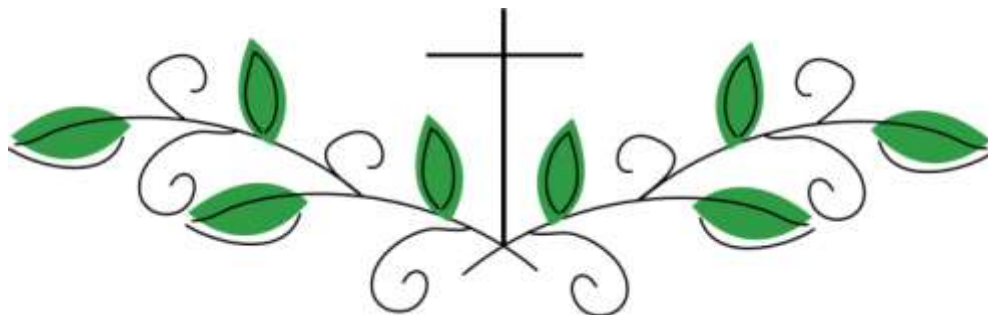

“Nourish the Future”

On the evening of February 4, Bread for the World launched their major initiative for this year, Nourish the Future. Rev. Eugene Cho, president of BFW spoke as well as representatives from both parties. The president of WIC spoke of Bread’s support through the years. Four persons impacted by help from WIC, or the Child Tax Credit, or SNAP on campus shared their experiences. Over 1200 persons participated virtually, and members of our church were among them.

Nourish the Future will involve legislation to fully fund and strengthen WIC, and provide robust funding for global nutrition programs. On Sunday, March 30, we will have the opportunity to participate in an Offering of Letters about Nourish the Future and speak up to our members of Congress. Please add your voice for hungry children in our country and around the world.

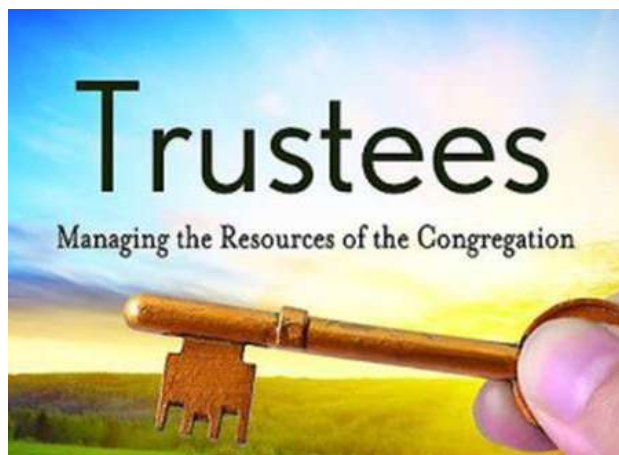


FINANCE COMMITTEE

Our monthly visits give us the great honor and opportunity to visit and serve in the name of Jesus Christ.

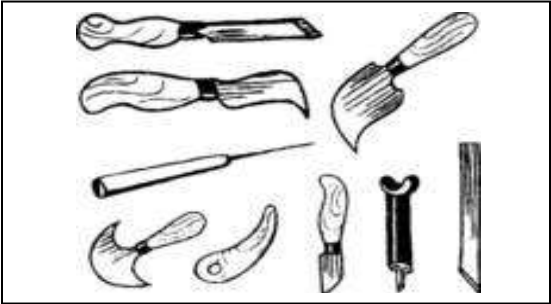
