<sup>3)</sup> Then Jesus went from the country of Judea to the country of Galilee. <sup>4)</sup> He had to go through the country of Samaria. <sup>5)</sup> So He came to a town in Samaria called Sychar. It was near the piece of ground that Jacob gave to his son Joseph.

<sup>6)</sup> Jacob’s well was there. Jesus was tired from traveling so He sat down just as He was by the well. It was about noon.

<sup>7)</sup> A woman of Samaria came to get water. Jesus said to her, “Give Me a drink.” <sup>8)</sup> His followers had gone to the town to buy food. <sup>9)</sup> The woman of Samaria said to Him, “You are a Jew. I am of Samaria.
